**UNLIKELY EVANGELISTS**

- 1) **SAMARITAN WOMAN: INVITE SOMEONE TO COME AND SEE.**

*Then, leaving her water jar, the woman went back to the town and said to the people, "Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Christ?" They came out of the town and made their way toward him. John 4:28-30*

- 2) **BLIND GUY: SHARE YOUR STORY.**

*... "Whether he is a sinner or not, I don't know. One thing I do know. I was blind but now I see!" John 9:25*

- 3) **DORCAS: GIVE YOUR LIFE AWAY.**

*In Joppa there was a disciple named Tabitha (which, when translated, is Dorcas), who was always doing good and helping the poor. Acts 9:36*

- 4) **PETER: GET IN SOMEONE'S FACE.**

*Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins...With many other words he warned them; and he pleaded with them, "Save yourselves from this corrupt generation." Acts 2:38, 40*
